Association of International Road Transport Carriers ZMPD would like to ask you for solving problem at the border crossing point PL- BY, Slawatycze – Domaczewo.

From 7.10.2016 traffic on the border crossing point Slawatycze – Domaczewo was resumed. This border crossing point was closed from 1.07.2016 because of works on bridge over the river Bug. We have been informed that after renovation it is possible to drive over the bridge vehicle much more than 7,5 tons.

We have received also information from our members that from 7.10.2016 goods vehicle up to 7,5 tons can not be entry this border crossing point and can not perform customs clearances with TIR carnets no more. This situation causes a lot of problems transport companies and above all causes prolonged border waiting times on the others border crossing points between Poland and Belarus.

We have talked to our polish border authorities and we have received information that polish side is ready for open this border crossing point for truck up to 7,5 tons. Polish Border Guard is waiting for official letter from belarusian side regarding of possibility passage through this border crossing point by trucks up to 7,5 tons. We would like to request for intervention in relevant belarusian border authorities regarding resume pilot traffic for goods vehicle up to 7,5 tons immediately.

We count for cooperation on this matter and waiting for answer from you concerning this very urgent issue for our both countries.
